

What Should I Do With My Old Trash Cans and Recycling Bin?



Residents are encouraged to repurpose their old trash cans whenever possible. Possible uses include:

- ▶ Storage for yard and garden equipment
- ▶ Compost
- ▶ Rain water collection
- ▶ Storage for sports equipment
- ▶ Storage for pet supplies



How to turn your trash can into a compost bin:

1

Drill holes in the bottom and sides of the garbage can to provide air circulation.

2

Place the can on bricks to keep it off the ground and provide air circulation under the can.

3

Add uncooked vegetable scraps, leaves, grass clippings and plant materials.

4

Keep the compost moist and turn it every two weeks. It can be turned by locking the lid in place and rolling it around.

If you would like to have your trash can recycled, two curb side pickups have been scheduled.



If **Monday, Tuesday, or Friday** is your trash pick-up day, we will pick up your old trash cans on **Saturday, May 5.**



If **Wednesday or Thursday** is your trash pick-up day, we will pick up your old trash cans on **Saturday, May 19.**

▶ To have your old trash cans picked up for recycling, they must be placed curbside on your pick up day **by 7 am and they must be empty.**

▶ There will be no alley pick ups.

▶ If there is trash in your cans, they will **NOT** be picked up.

Blue Recycling Bins: If you would like to keep your blue recycling bin for other uses, you are welcome to do so. If you would like us to pick it up, please have it at the curb on the same day that we will be picking up your old trash cans.
