Recycling, Landfill Trash, and Yard Waste Information for the Citizens of Bellevue, Nebraska

Fall Clean Up Is Saturday, October 9

Mark your calendars for fall clean up on Saturday, October 9. City Street Department areas located at 29th & Hancock and 8252 Cedar Island Road will be open from 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM on that day for residents to drop off solid waste.

This cleanup is for City of Bellevue residents. Please bring your previous month's M.U.D. bill showing the trash fee to prove residency because this trash fee pays for the clean-up. The Fall Clean Up is restricted to residential items only. Commercial and business items will not be accepted and no vehicles larger than pickup trucks will be permitted unless prior arrangements are made.

If you are a senior citizen or an individual with disabilities and need assistance, Papillion Sanitation will only be able to collect bulk items curbside from residents that meet the City's requirements for this service. Recycling: Keep up the Good Work

In 2020, residents of Bellevue recycled 18 percent of their solid waste. That means more than 3100 tons of solid waste was diverted from the landfill. In 2018, that number was only 14 percent. Way to be green Bellevue!

Remember, you can choose any size recycling cart at no additional cost. Pricing for City of Bellevue trash service is based only on the size of your landfill trash cart. So go ahead—recycle more and maybe even save money.

Recyclables include cans, paper, and plastics 1—7. Make sure you rinse all items and place them in your recycling cart loose because plastic grocery bags are NOT accepted at the recycling processing facility. These bags may be returned to grocery stores for recycling.



Recycling is easy.

Just know what goes in your cart: cans, cardboard, paper and plastics 1-7.

Yard Waste Season Reminder

November 30 marks the end of yard waste season. From December 1 through March 31 you may use your brown cart for landfill trash.

During yard waste season, leaves, lawn clippings, dead plant material, and twigs less than one inch in diameter may be placed in your brown yard waste cart. Larger branches should be bundled and placed in your landfill trash cart or taken to the free tree dump at the gated entrance just north of 8902 Cedar Island Road on the last Saturday of every month from 8 am to 12 pm.

Yard waste that does not fit in your cart may be placed in brown bio bags and placed next to your cart. There is no limit to the number of bags you may put out, however, your yard waste cart must also be curbside so that the driver can place the bags in the cart to lift into the truck.
