## FALL CLEAN UP IS SATURDAY OCTOBER 10

Mark your calendars for fall clean up on Saturday, October 10th. City Street Department areas located at 29th & Hancock and 8252 Cedar Island Road will be open from 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM on that day for residents to drop off solid waste.

This cleanup is for City of Bellevue residents. Please bring your previous month's M.U.D. bill showing the trash fee to prove residency because this trash fee pays for the clean-up. The City is also requesting food item donations to support the Bellevue Food Pantry.

The Fall Clean Up is restricted to residential items only. Commercial and business items will not be accepted and no vehicles larger than pickup trucks will be permitted unless prior arrangements are made. Accepted items include: furniture, mattresses, carpet, toys, appliances, storm doors/windows, lawn mowers, snow blowers, bikes, auto parts, propane tanks, fencing, lumber, drywall, concrete, masonry, landscape timbers, sinks, toilets, and electronics. We will not accept tires, boats, campers, TVs, computer monitors, trees, brush, yard waste, automotive oil, paint and hazardous waste. If you are a senior citizen or an individual with disabilities and need assistance, Papillion Sanitation will only be able to collect bulk items curbside from residents that meet the City's requirements for this service. Please call Papillion Sanitation at 402-346-7800 to schedule your collection.

## HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Here is what you need to know about how holidays will affect your service schedule:

Labor Day - Sep 7 - CLOSED Service will be delayed one day for the entire week. Friday routes will be run on Saturday.

Columbus Day - Oct 12 - OPEN  
Veterans Day - Nov 11- OPEN  
Thanksgiving - Nov 26- CLOSED  
Thursday routes will be run on Friday and Friday routes will be run on Saturday.

Christmas Eve - Dec 24 - OPEN  
Christmas Day - Dec 25 - CLOSED  
Friday routes will be run on Saturday.  
New Years Eve - OPEN  
New Years Day - CLOSED - Friday routes will be run on Saturday.

## YARD WASTE SEASON ENDS NOVEMBER 30

Compostable yard waste goes in your brown cart. Yard waste season runs April 1–November 30. From December 1–March 31, brown carts may be used for landfill trash.

- Yard waste includes leaves, lawn clippings, prunings, weeds, and dead plant material.
- Yard waste that does not fit in the cart may be placed in brown bio bags and placed alongside the brown cart. If using bio bags, your brown cart must also be at the curb, and the bags should not weigh more than 40 pounds. Please do NOT put your yard waste in plastic bags.
- The price you pay for trash service is based solely ON THE SIZE OF LANDFILL TRASH CART SELECTED. You are not required to receive a recycling or compostable yard waste cart, however, these carts are included with the price of the landfill trash cart.
- Branches over one inch in diameter (about the size of your thumb) are considered landfill trash as they cannot be composted. They must be cut to a size that will fit in your blue cart with the lid closed. You may also take them to the City's free tree dump located at 8902 Cedar Island Road on the last Saturday of the month from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
